• Trainings and outreach aid agencies, line ministries, civil society


Component III: Policy Support



### **Key Terms**

- Commitments: Amount given in the agreement for the life of the project.
- **Disbursements:** Funding transferred from donor to executing or implementing agency.
- Expenditures: Funding spent by implementing agency.
- **Donor/Funding Organization:** Organizations that provide funding for the project.
- Executing Agency: If there are multiple donor organizations, the organization that is managing the funds.
- Implementing Agency: Organization that carries out project activities.
