


EXERTING INFLUENCE: HIGHLIGHTS

SPRING is reaching women and children under two in Bangladesh through the training of health workers and agriculture extension officers, and through farmer nutrition schools.



SPRING WORKS ACROSS SECTORS TO STRENGTHEN NUTRITION

Trained 126,255 women to improve household agriculture, hygiene, and nutrition through 6,421 Farmer Nutrition Schools Completed a Farmer Nutrition School Toolkit with technical and session guides and flashcards in both English and Bangla to facilitate scale up and replication Supported routine nutrition-related monitoring and supervision in 1,095 community clinics and 309 union health and family welfare centers Distributed materials to 1,404 health facilities across 40 *upazilas* to reinforce messages promoting Essential Nutrition and Hygiene Actions
