What are we trying to achieve?

Provide technical cooperation to:

- 1. Improve the nutritional status of women of reproductive age and children under five** by implementing Essential Nutrition Actions, focusing on “the first thousand days”
- 2. Strengthen essential maternal, neonatal and child health care and family planning services** at the community level with a permanent health care presence in target communities, and
- 3. Engage communities** in active solutions to their health care and nutrition needs through community mobilization and linkages to local government structures.

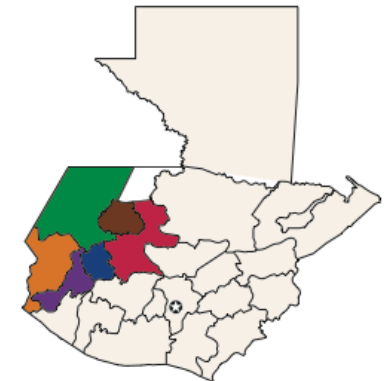
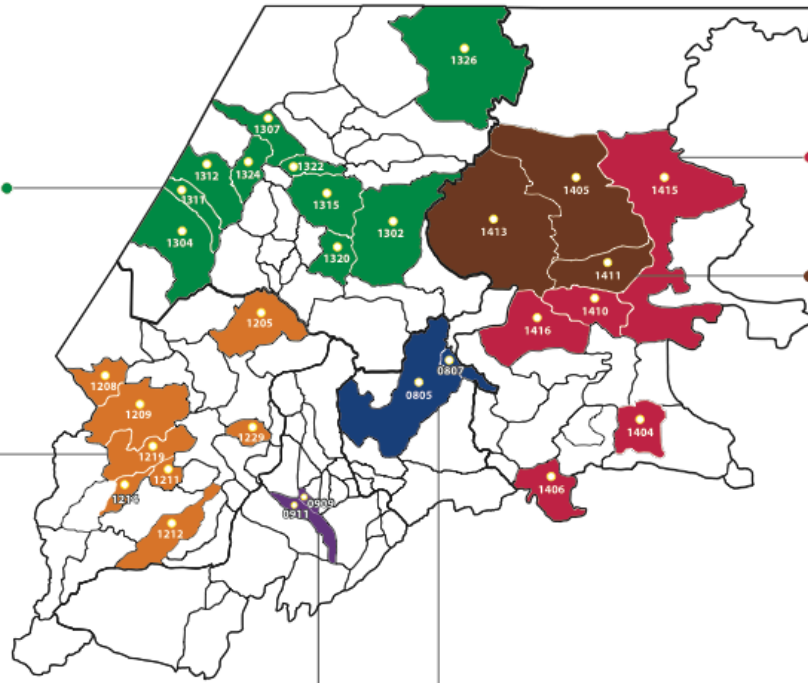

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How do we work? Lines of Action

1. MOH – Strengthening of the first level of care

- Strategy for Communities (2041)
- Strategy for Extension of Coverage NGOs (19 NGOs, 69 jurisdictions, 408 Convergence Centers)
- Strategy with Health Posts (126 health posts)

Collaboration with other USAID health projects.

Examples:

- ✓ **URC/ TRAction for second and third level of care linkages**
- ✓ **APROFAM and PSI/ PASMO Plan Fam for family planning**
- ✓ **DELIVER for logistics of drugs and other supplies**

3. Ag-N Collaboration (RVC and Title II)

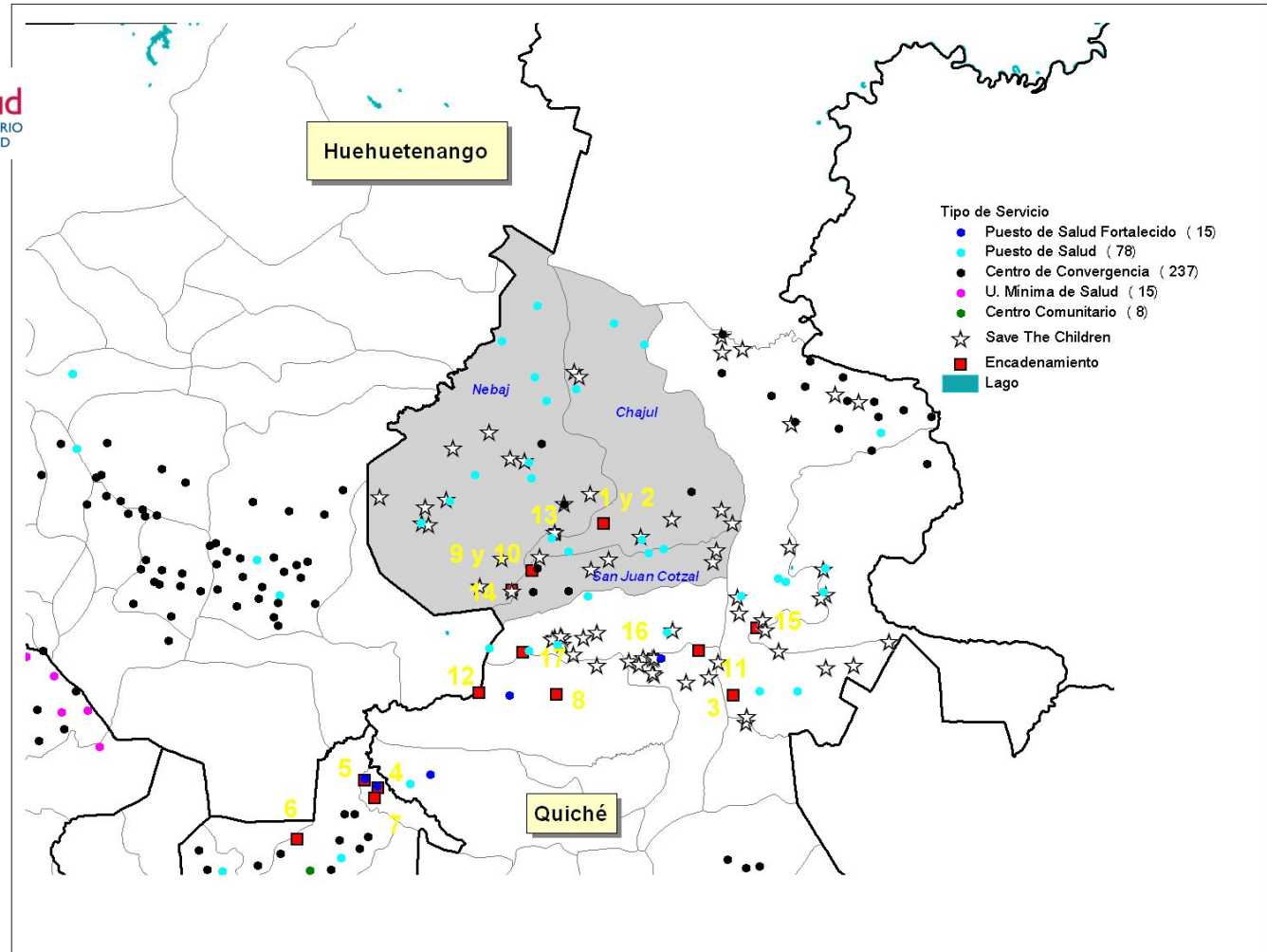

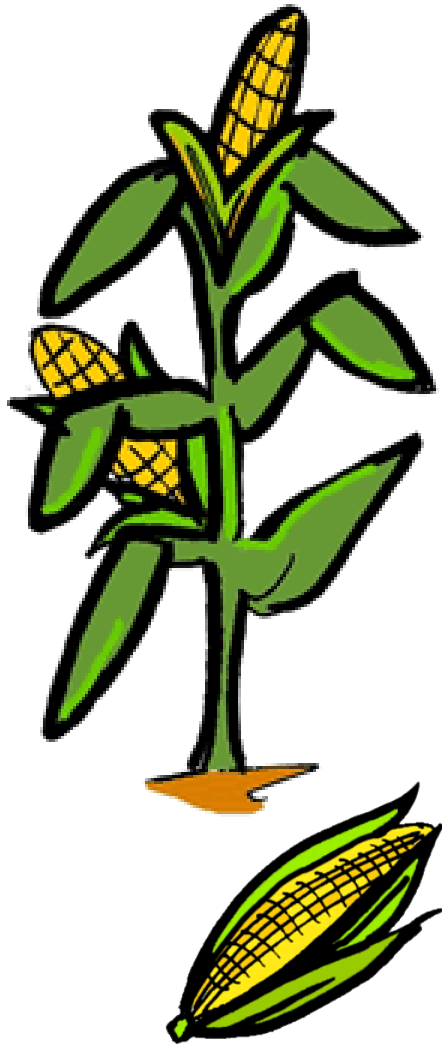
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Some topics in which to collaborate?
