Connecting people and institutions to strengthen analysis and decision making

- Critical **need for timely and accurate food and nutrition security information**
- Need for **harmonization of approaches** to increase cost-effectiveness and reduce fragmentation of data and duplication of efforts
- Donor-led initiatives **limit country and regional ownership and sustainability** of these systems

Enable developing countries to build sustainable information systems on food and nutrition security:

- Establish **a global community of practice** to share knowledge, best practices and lessons learned
- Provide access to **demand-driven harmonized sets of standards, methods, tools and indicators**
- Strengthen **country and regional level capacities**

Community of Practice launched in September 2013

- **FSIN Community of Practice : 450+ members**
- Community of practice dedicated to **Resilience Measurement : 310+ members**

Moving Resilience Measurement forward

- **FSIN** is facilitating the improvement and harmonization of resilience measurement approaches:
 - **Established a Technical Working Group (TWG)** composed of recognized experts
 - **A community of practice** to share standards, methods and lessons learned among practitioners
 - **Resilience Measurement papers**
 - Paper on Measurement design principles and definition of resilience
 - Develop an analytical framework and field guidance for RM (mid-2014)

Resilience Measurement

- Support **field level activities**, including regional Resilience Analysis Units

TWG on FNS Measurement

- Establish TWG to reach agreement on a **core set of FNS indicators** e.g. to support the Post 2015 MDGs

Facilitate Capacity Development on FNS Analysis

- Identification of **strengths and gaps** in the production and use of food and nutrition security information
- Develop country-led, coordinated **action plans for capacity development**
