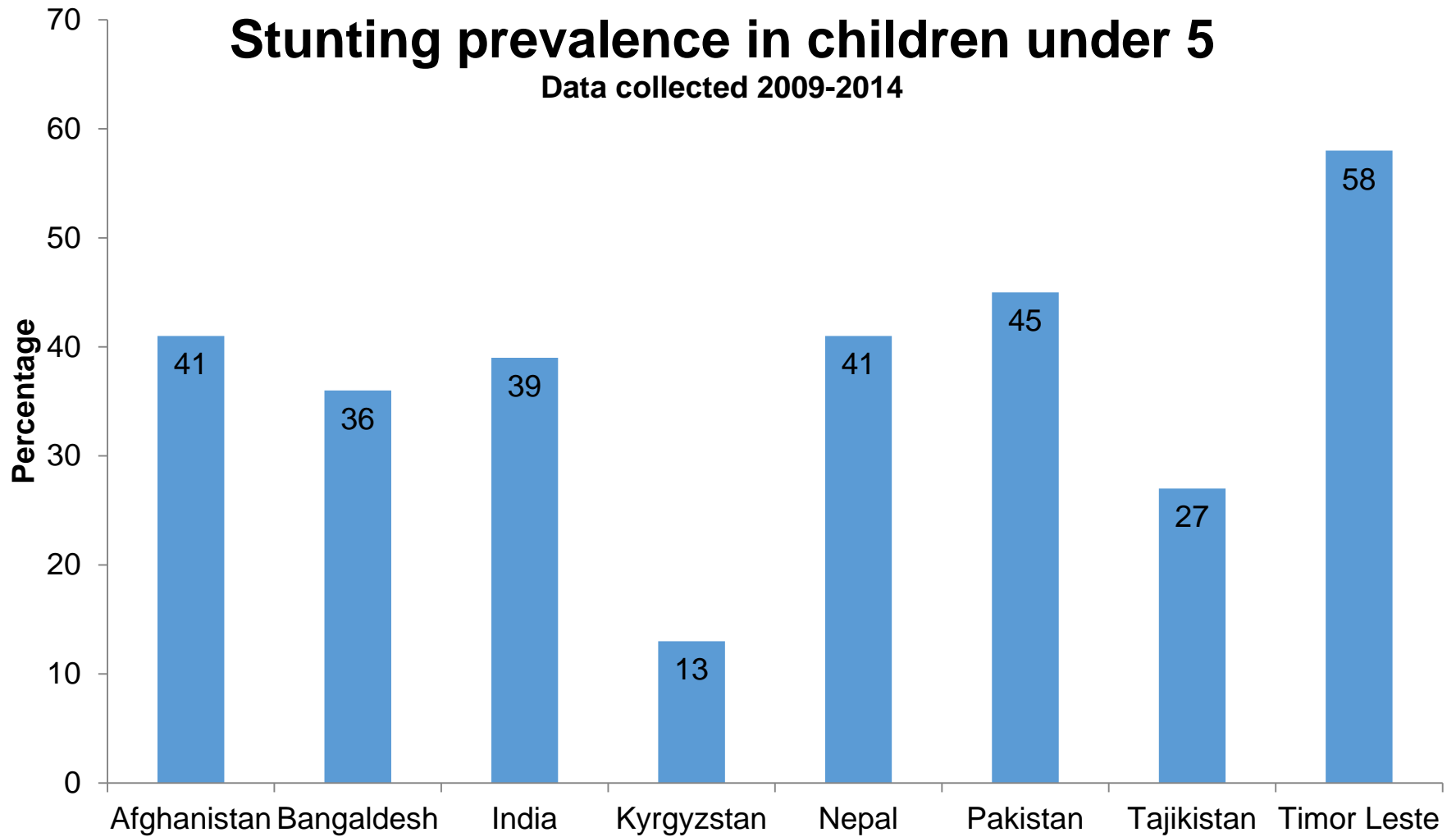

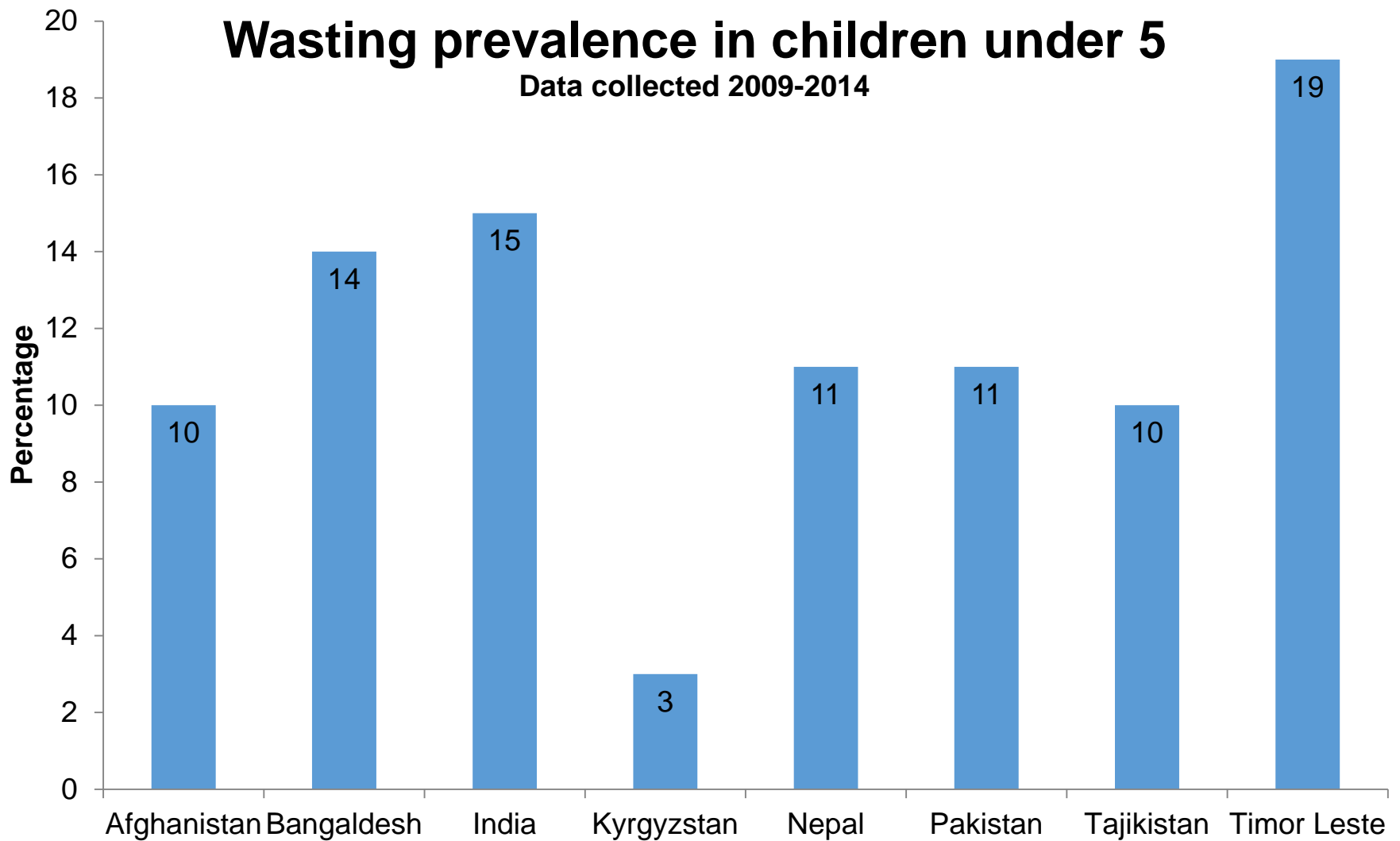

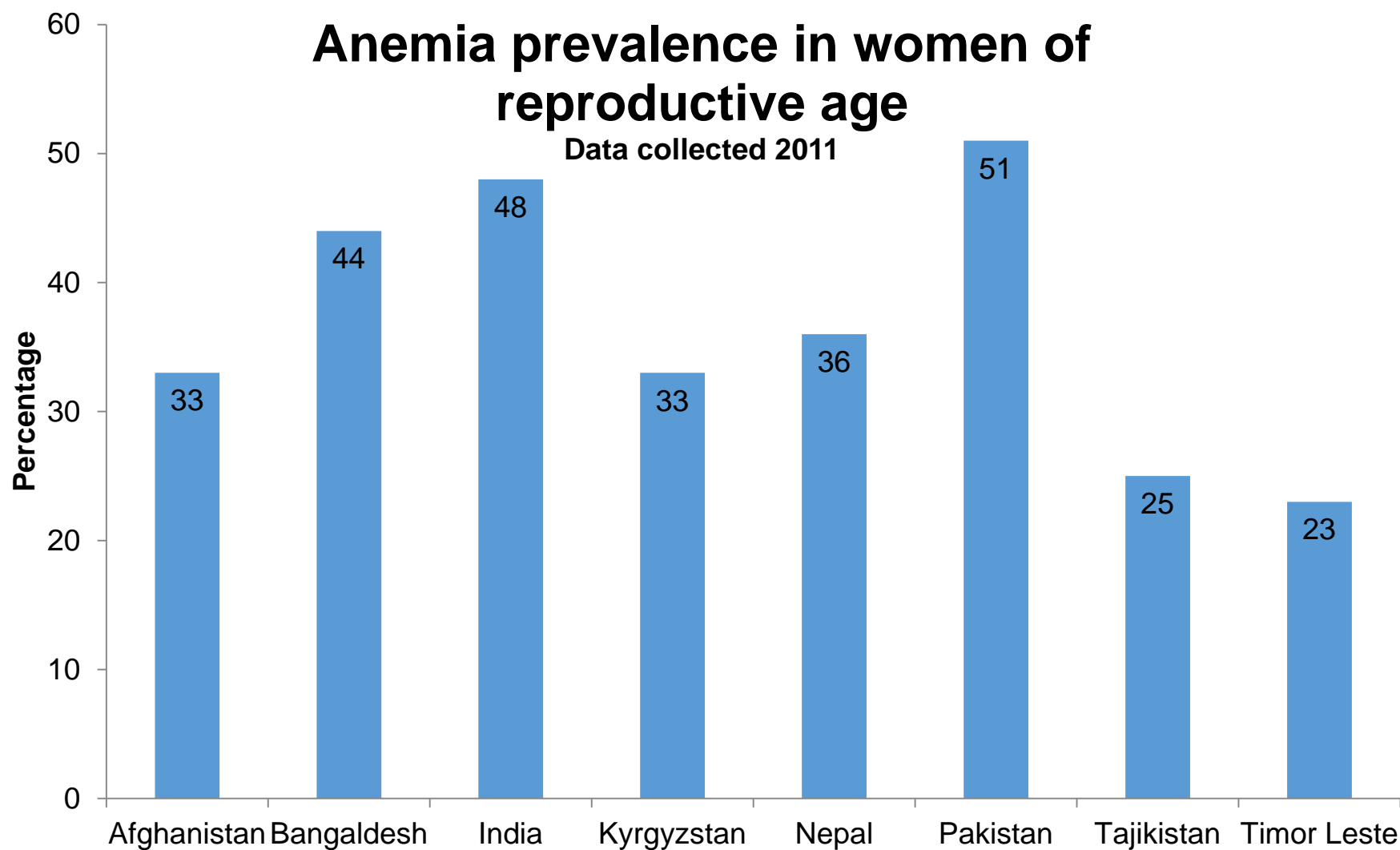

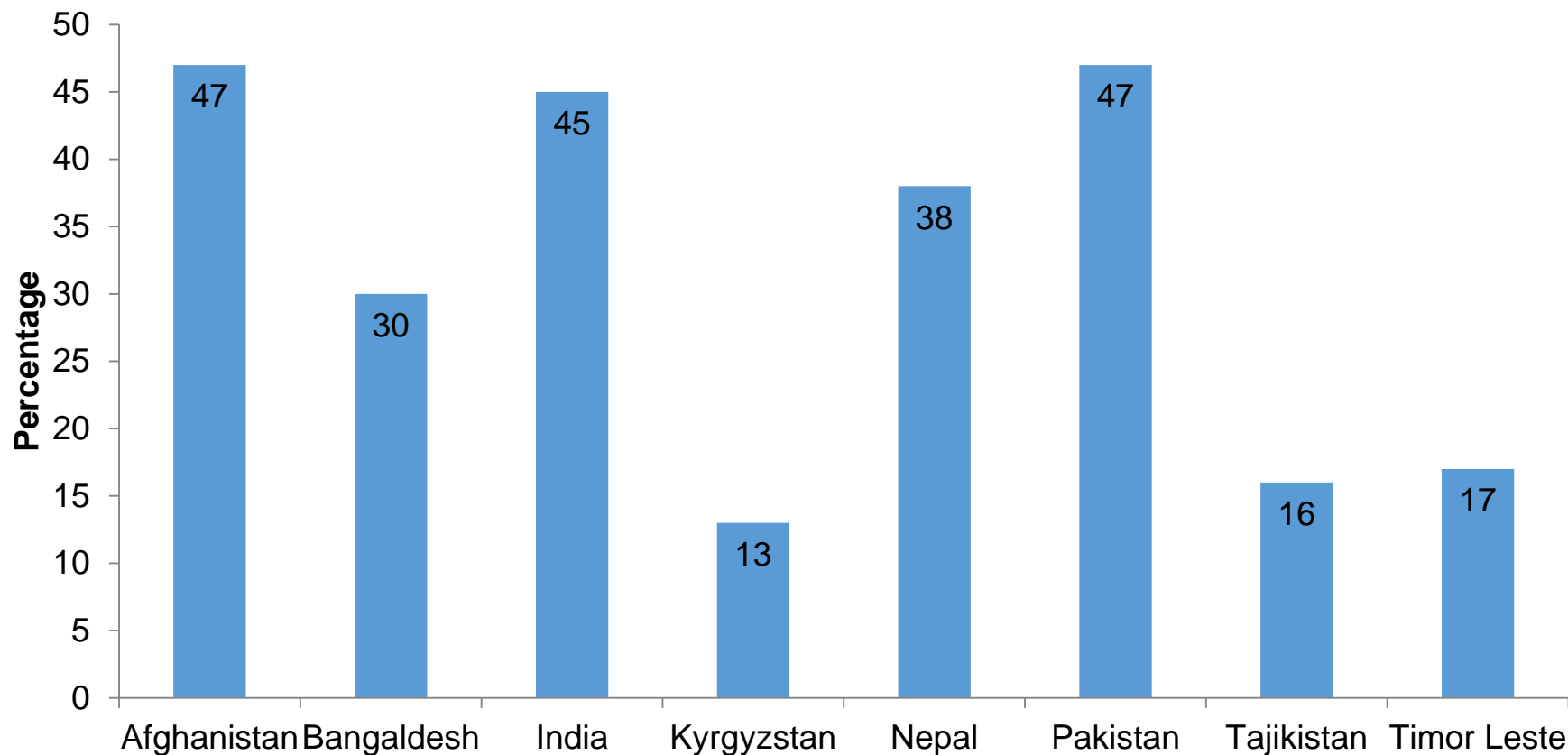

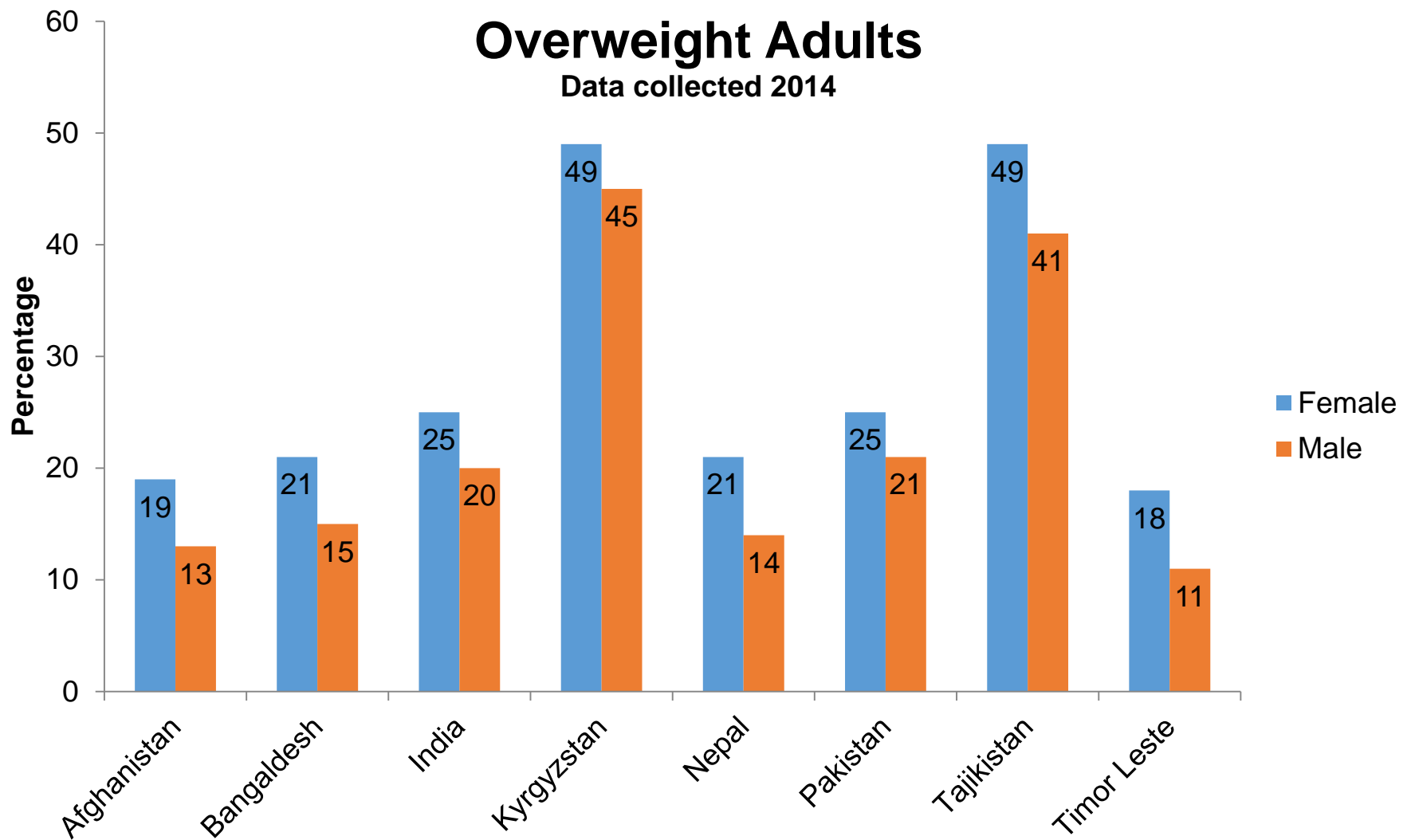

Vitamin A deficiency prevalence in children 6-59 months old

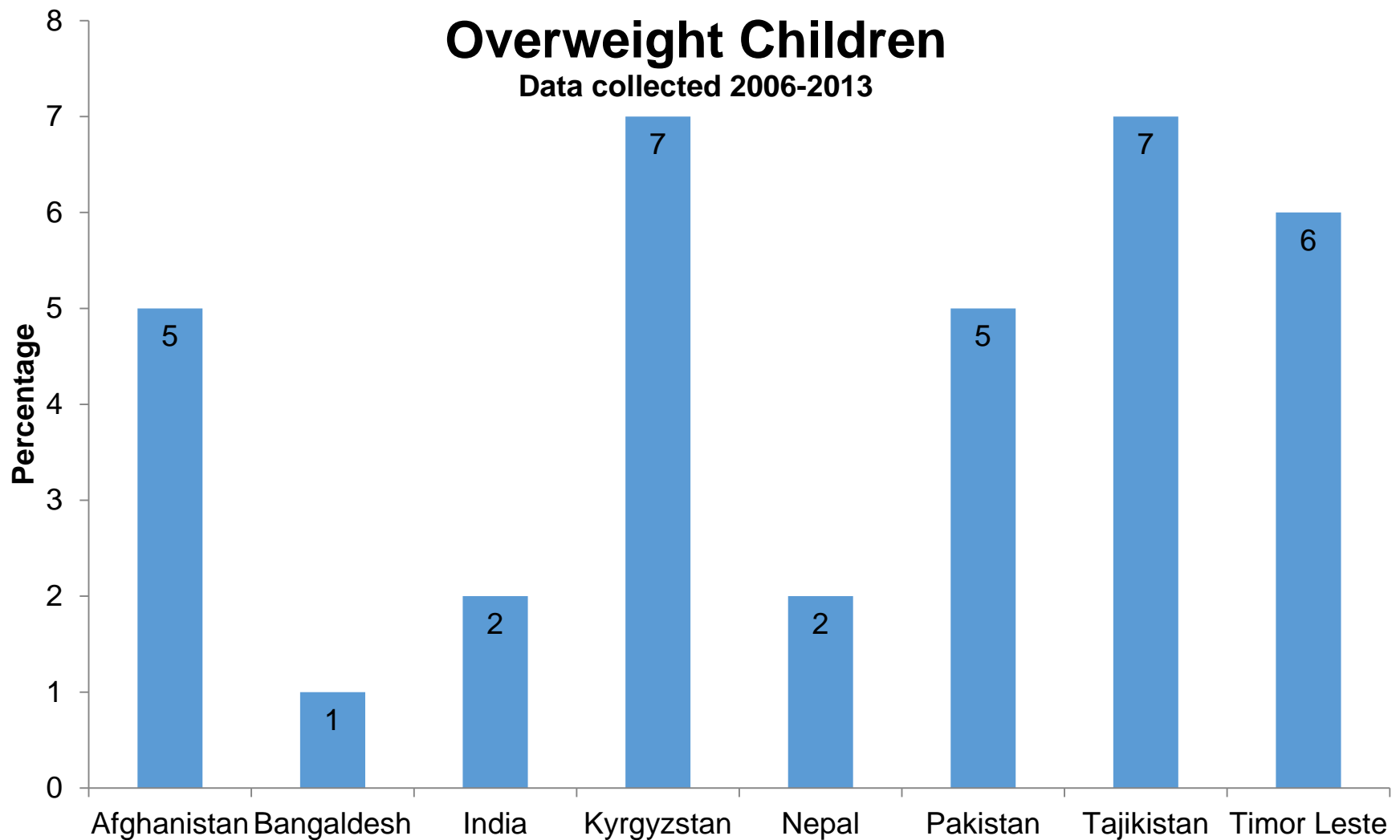

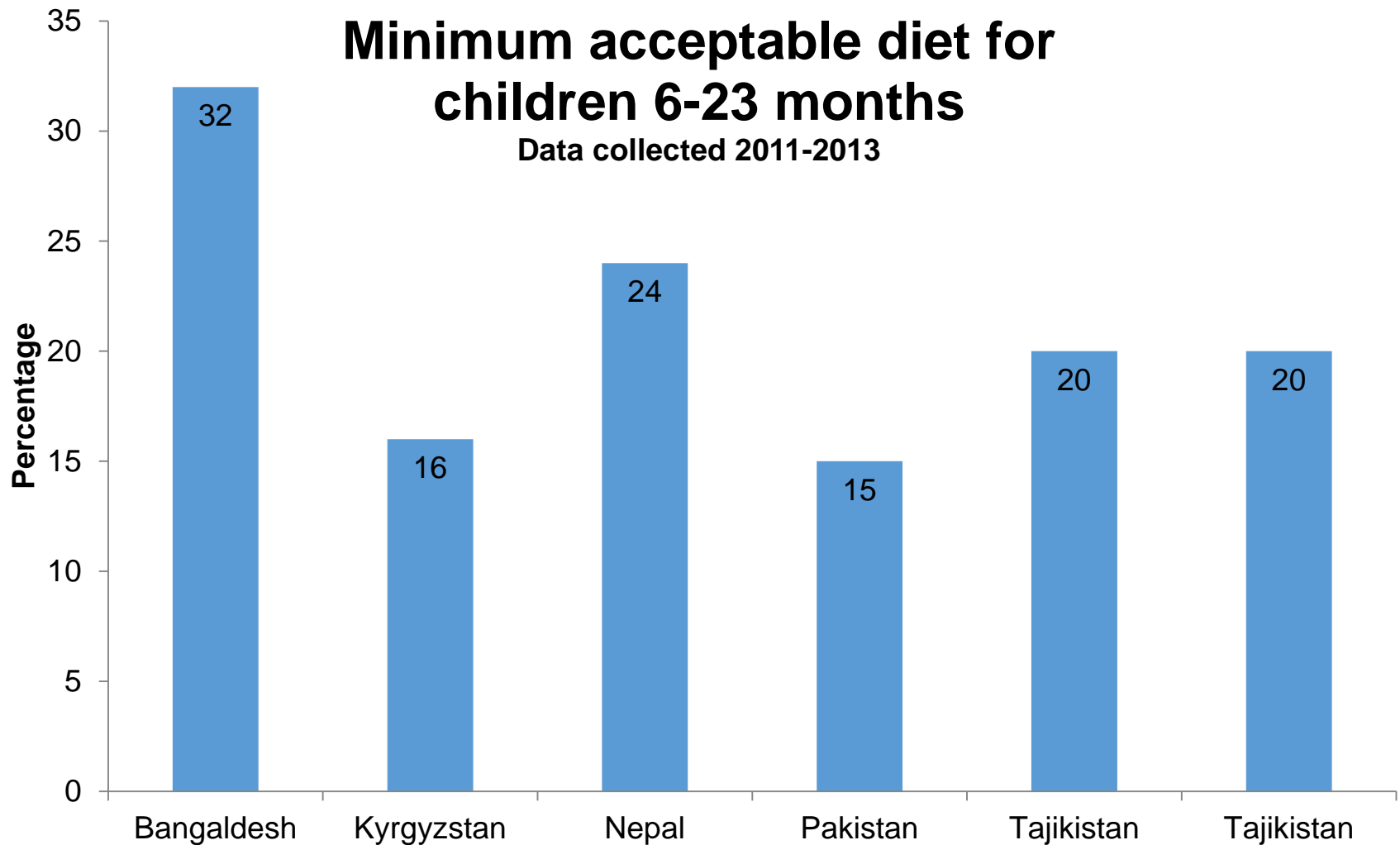
Adult overweight and obesity



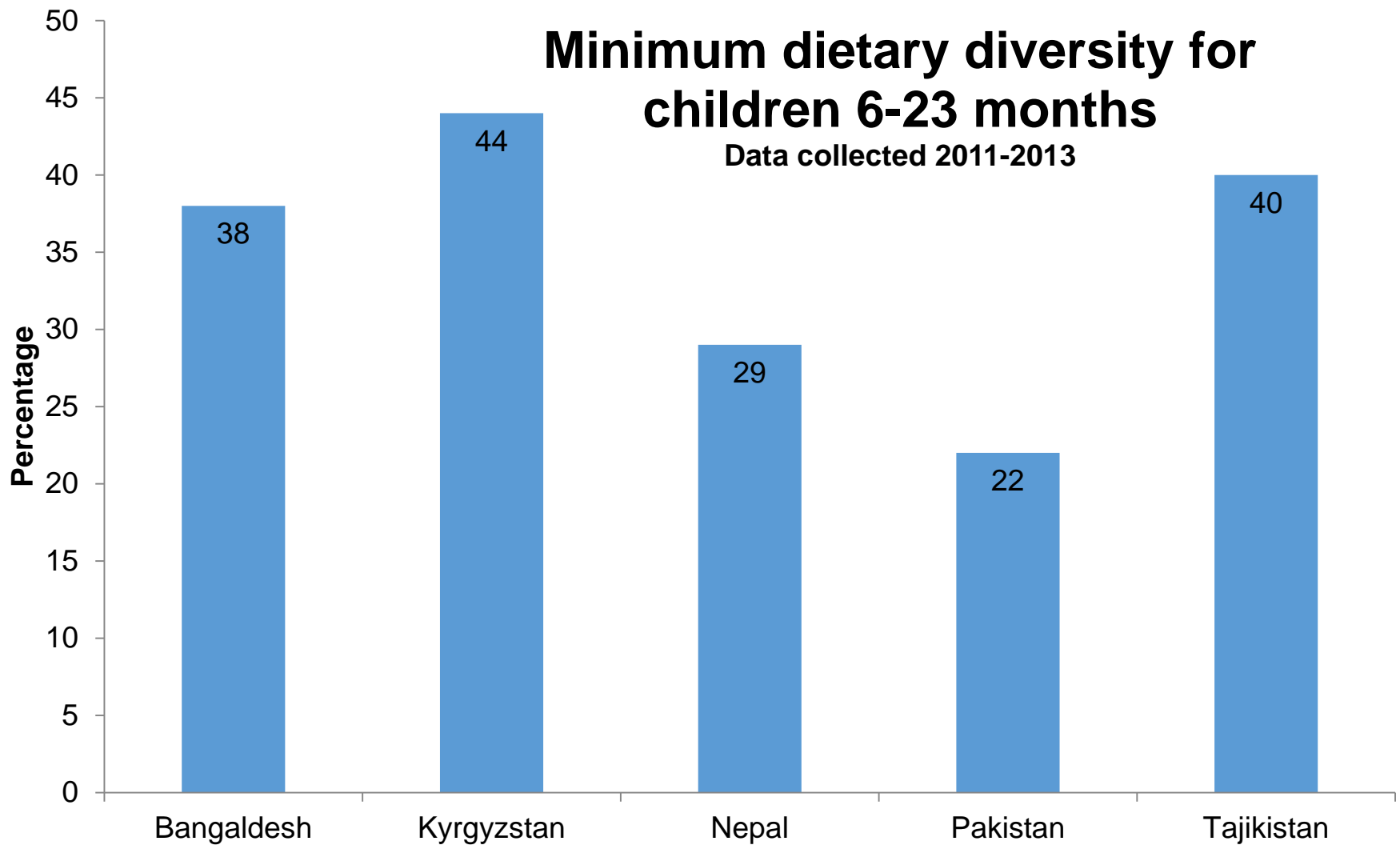
Child overweight



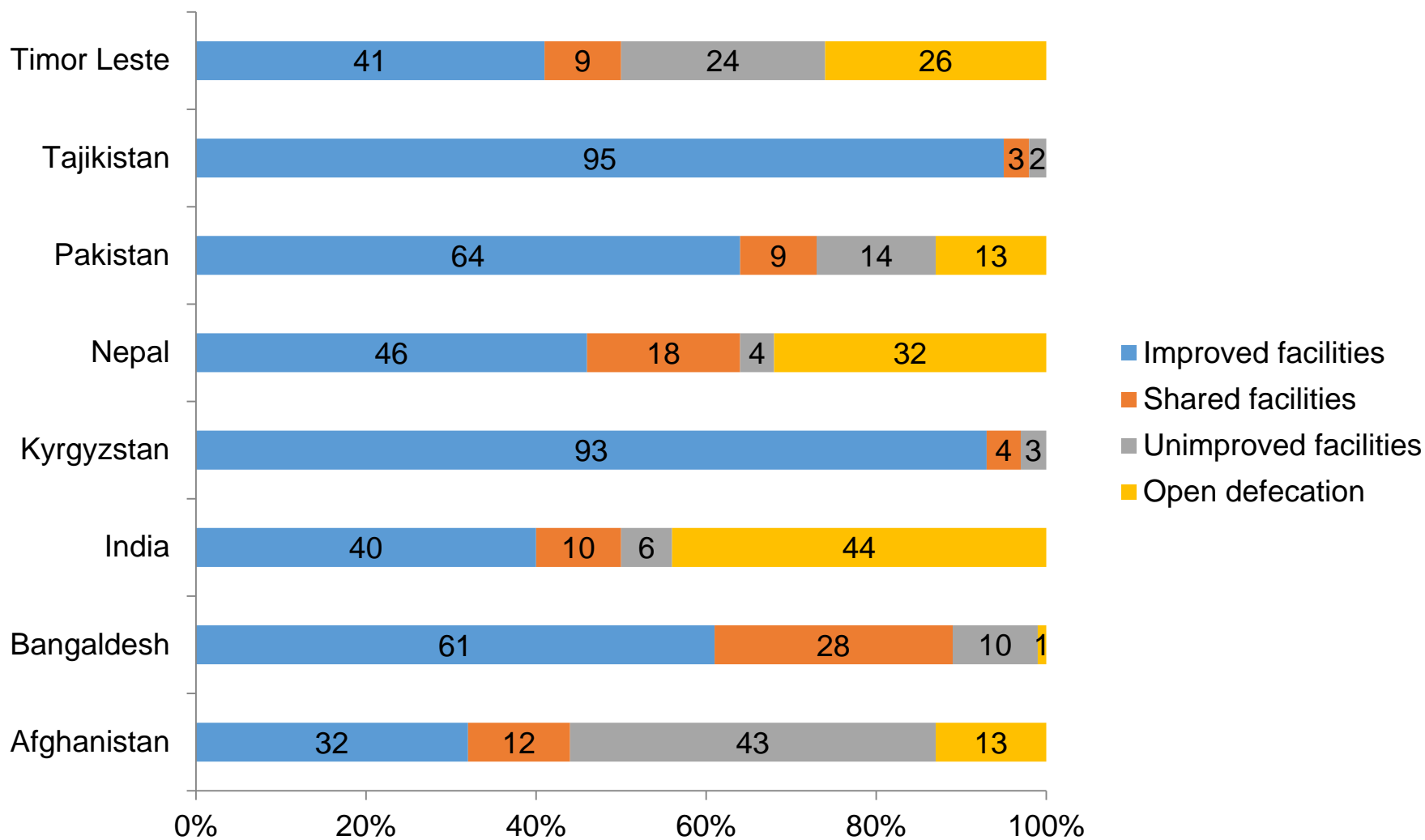
Infant and Young Child Feeding Practices
