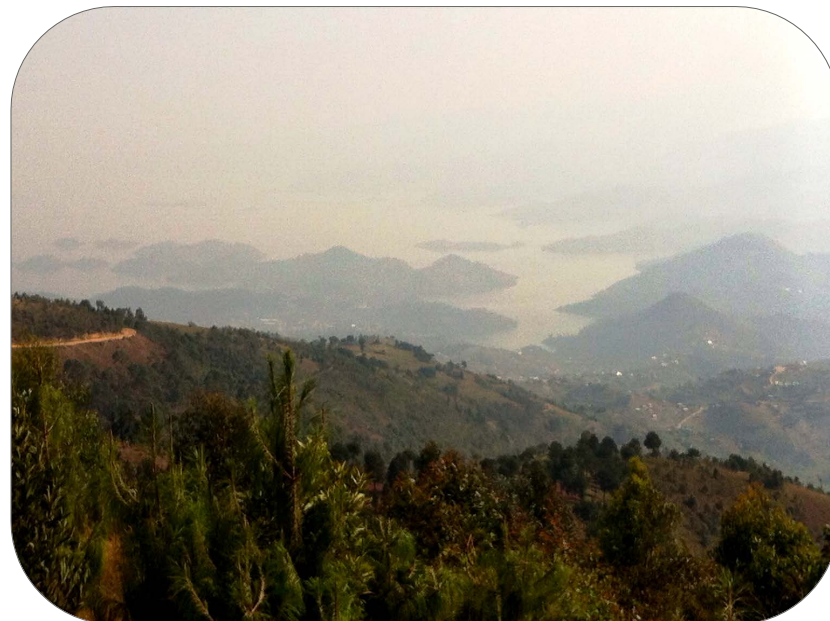

- How can we measure effectiveness of coordination and collaboration plans?

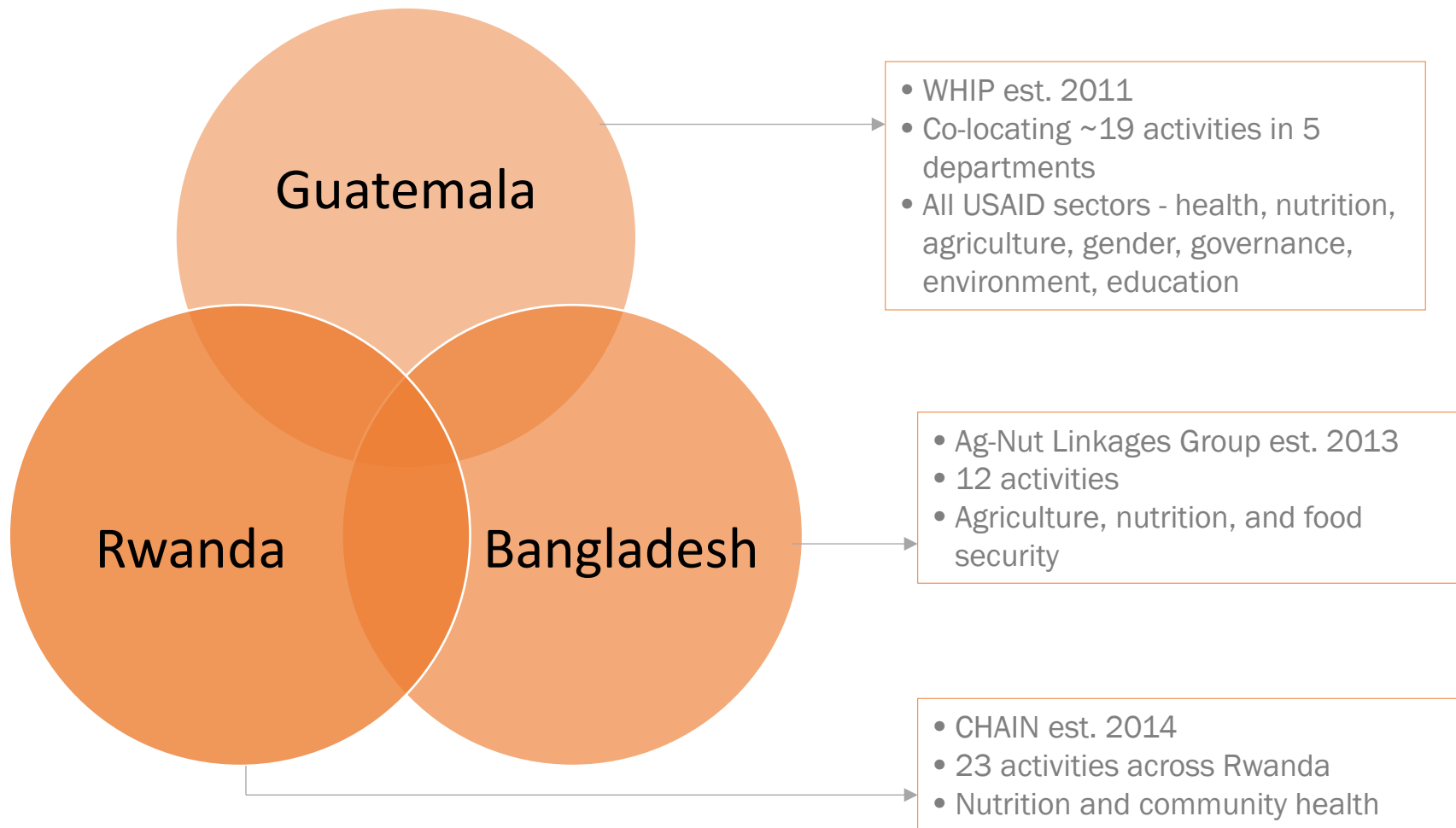


SPRING'S PROCESS

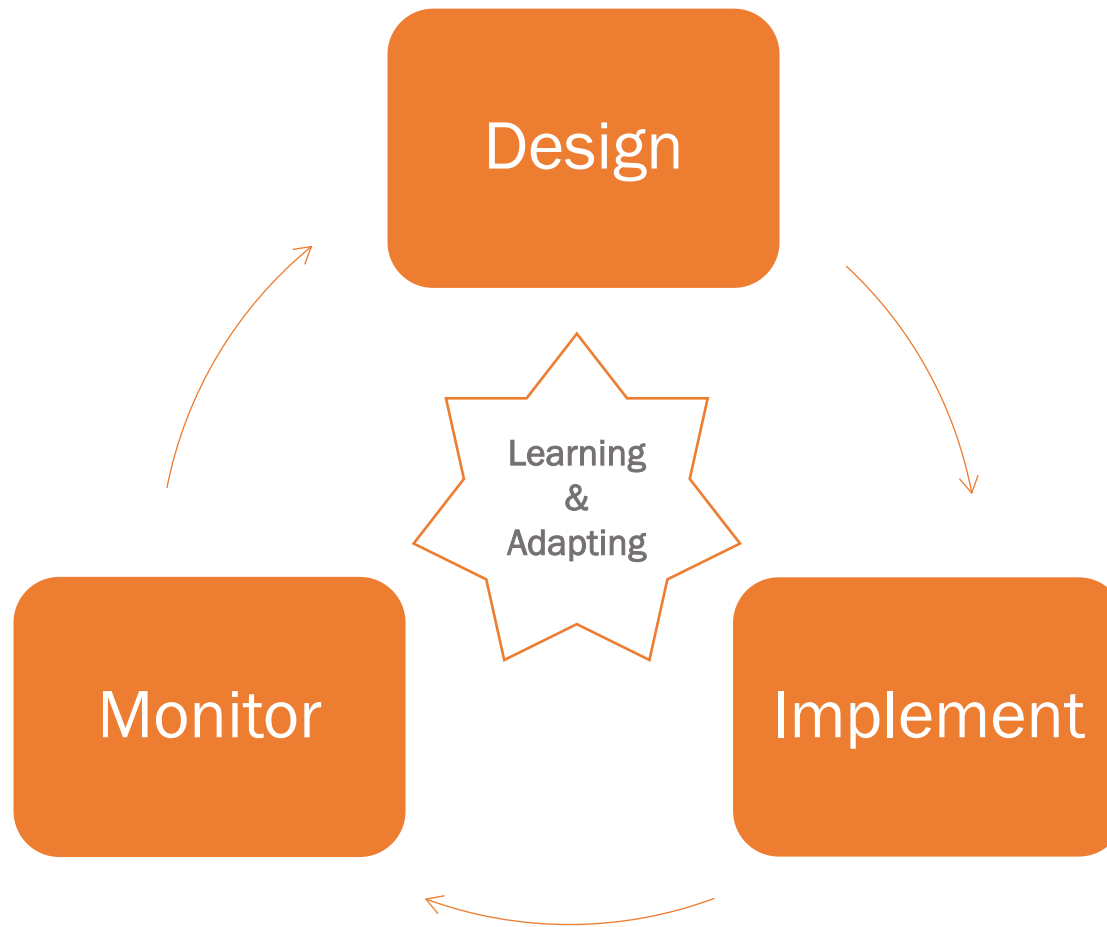
- Performed document review

- Document key findings in a larger technical brief
